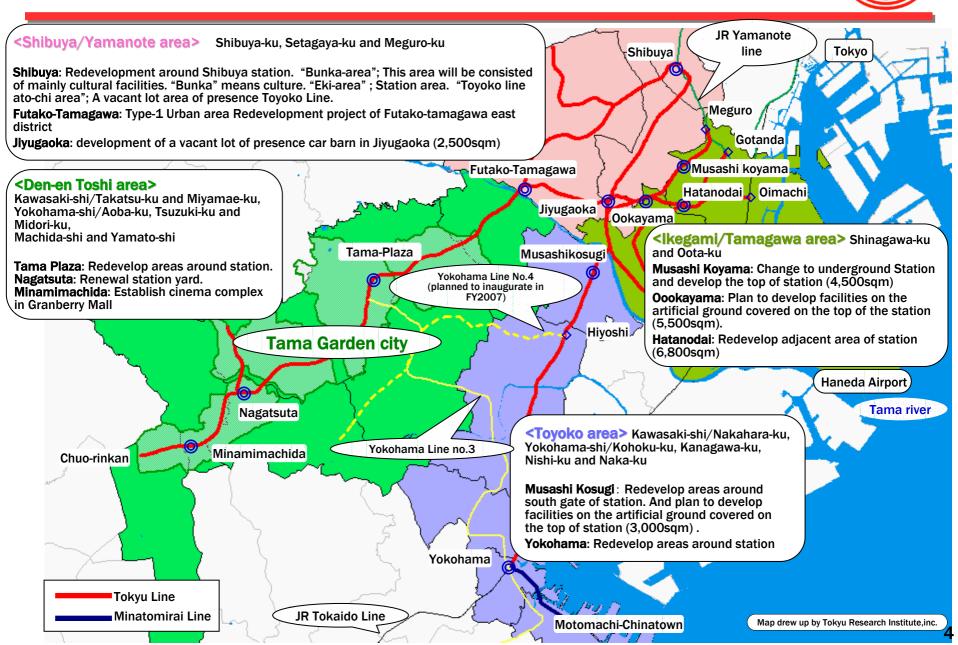

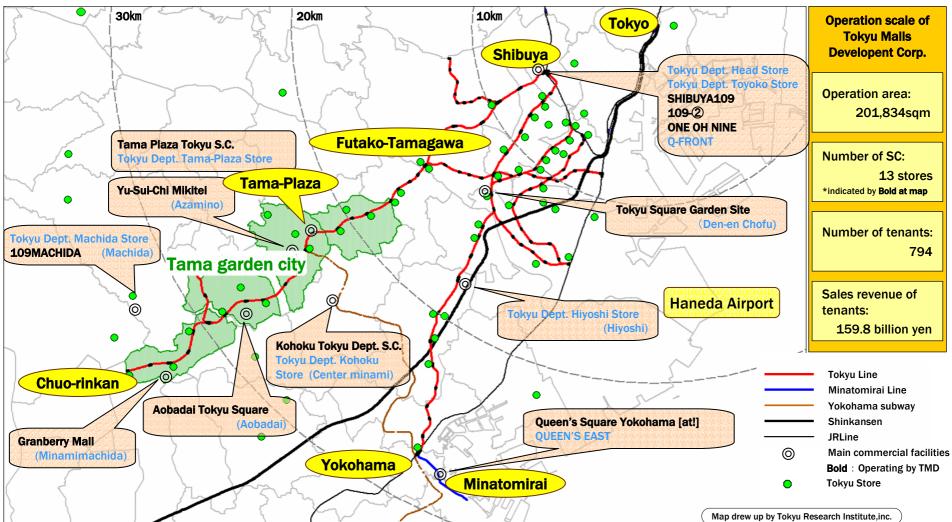

### Redevelopment of Four areas based on Area Strategy



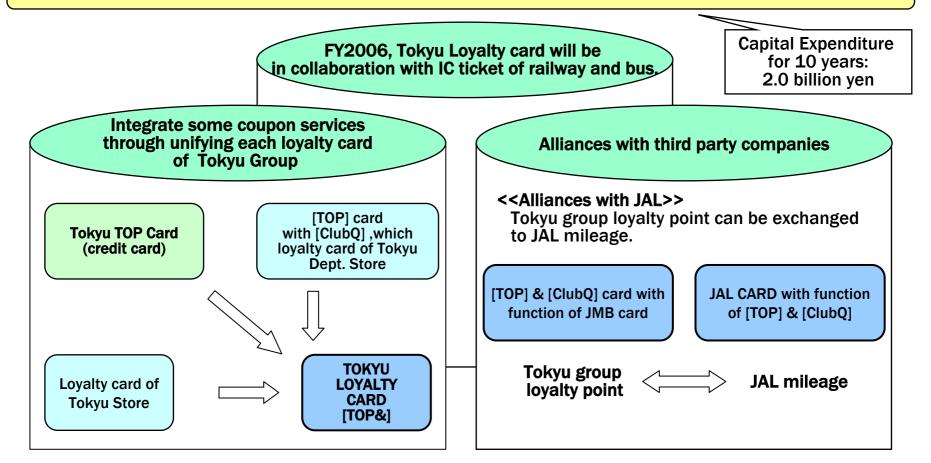
### Integrate Management and Operation of Commercial Facilities in Tokyu Group
